Key Scriptures

And **Jesus** increased in **wisdom** (in broad and full understanding) and in stature and years, and in **favor** with **God and man**. Luke 2:52 AMP

Integrity as God sees it in the Bible. Commentary

- A. Today, we will discuss verses from the Bible that relate to **integrity**. **Integrity** is about doing the right thing, even when no one is watching. It's an important trait in our Christian Walk, reflecting our commitment to living according to God's values. The Bible is full of **wisdom** on **integrity**, reminding us to be honest, fair, and true to our word. As we dive into these verses, let us meditate on how we can embody **integrity** in our daily lives, representing Christ's love and truth wherever we go.
 - In the biblical context, Integrity is defined as the quality of being honest and having strong moral principles. It involves consistency in thoughts, words, and actions, aligning them with God's truth and principles. Integrity emphasizes doing what is right, even when it is difficult, and being truthful, reliable, and consistent. In the Old Testament, it refers to being "without blemish" and "completeness", while in the New Testament, it signifies honesty and adherence to good works. Integrity is steadfast adherence to a code of moral values, and in the biblical context, it is often associated with righteousness, truthfulness, and uprightness. The Bible presents integrity as an essential foundation for a life that honors God and reflects His character.

B. Confirming scriptures

- a. "For the LORD God is a sun and a shield; the LORD; He gives grace and glory; He withholds no good thing from those who walk with **integrity**." Psalm 84:11 NET
- b. "May integrity and honesty protect me, for I put hope in you." Psalm 25:21 NLT
- c. "The **integrity** of the upright will guide them, But the perversity of the unfaithful will destroy them." Proverbs 11:3 NKJV
- d. "To proclaim the accepted and acceptable year of the Lord (the day when salvation and the free **favors** of God profusely abound)." Luke 4:19 AMP

- e. "Even when we were dead (slain) by (your own) shortcomings and trespasses, He made us alive together in fellowship and in union with Christ; (He gave us the very life of Christ Himself the same new life with which He quickened Him, for) it is by grace (His **favor** and mercy which you did not deserve) that you are saved (delivered from judgement and made partakers of Christ's salvation)." Ephesians 2:5 AMP
- f. "And the LORD said to Moses, I will do this thing also that you have asked, for you have found **favor**, loving kindness, and mercy in My sight and I know you personally and by name." Exodus 33:17 AMP
- g. "You will arise and have mercy on Zion; For the time to **favor** her, Yes, the set time, has come." Psalm 102:13 NJK

C. Areas that will hinder walking in Integrity & Favor

- "And whenever you stand praying, if you have anything against anyone, forgive him, that your Father in heaven may also forgive you your trespasses." "But if you do not forgive, neither will your Father in heaven forgive your trespasses." Mark 11:25-26 NKJV
- **Pride** goes before destruction, and a haughty spirit before a fall. Proverbs 16:18 NKJV

D. Testimonies about Integrity and Favor

- Recently, I was meditating on Favor, and the Holy Spirit dropped the word Integrity in my spirit. I believe the Lord was telling me that for me, or any Believer, to experience Favor they would have to conduct themselves according to the Bible and walk in Integrity.
- About two months ago, I realized that our dentist was no longer in our dental insurance network. I began searching for another provider and found one that provided coverage for both of us. I took Jean in, and the new dentist recommended replacing five teeth with a bridge. After receiving the plan, I asked them to confirm our coverage. They checked and told me the insurance would cover the entire cost—praise God! The new bridge is working great. Through it all, I kept listening to the Holy Spirit's direction and claiming **favor** every step of the way.
- Not long after that, I received a text from the dentist's office saying they would no longer be in our network starting September 1st. We both scheduled routine cleanings about 10 days before the coverage ended. During my visit, I asked the dentist to check my teeth and put together a plan before the change took effect. After examining me, he said I needed one crown, one tooth pulled, and two fillings. Once again, I asked them to check with our insurance—and again, everything was covered! The crown was completed in just two hours using the latest dental technology. I knew the Holy Spirit was guiding me, and as I continued to declare God's favor,

- everything was taken care of. Thank you, Jesus! (Psalm 84:11 NET, Genesis 26:12 AMP, Proverbs 11:3 NKJV)
- On September 19th, I had to go to the grocery store twice that day. Each time, I prayed and believed God for a handicap parking spot near the front door and for an electric cart to be available close by. Both times, God provided exactly what I asked for. This might seem like a small thing, but that's often the best place to start—trusting God in the little details and watching His favor show up.
- For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, these are the sons of God.
 Romans 8:14 NJKV
- But without **faith** it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him. Hebrew 11:6 NKJV

E. Living with Honesty - Integrity

Living with **honesty** is a cornerstone of **integrity**. As followers of Christ, we are called to be transparent in our dealings and **truthful in our words**. **Honesty** builds trust, both with God and others. When we open our hearts and minds to the value of honesty, we foster relationships that reflect God's love. This is essential, as **our words** have the power to uplift or tear down. (Prov. 18:21) Let's commit to living **honestly** and sharing **God's truth** in all aspects of our lives; by embracing the **integrity** we read about in the Bible.

F. Integrity in Trials

Trials test our **integrity**, revealing what we are truly made of. When we encounter challenges, our reactions can determine our strength in faith. It's during these tough moments that we can either stand firm in our **integrity** or waver. The Bible encourages us to remain steadfast, reminding us that the challenges are opportunities for growth. By trusting God in our trials, we affirm our commitment to **integrity** and witness His power in our lives.

G. Keeping our Word

Our words hold significant weight, and keeping our promises is a vital aspect of **integrity**. The Bible teaches us the importance of being people of our word and following through on our commitments. When we are trustworthy, we reflect God's faithfulness to us. By keeping our word, we encourage others to do the same and create a culture of **integrity**. Let's remind ourselves how crucial it is to be faithful to our promises, for it's a direct expression of our love for God and others.

2. Favor as God sees it in the Bible.

Commentary

- A. Once you call for **God's favor**, you now have the advantage of all of heaven backing you up! That's how power the **favor of God** is once you learn the keys of walking in it every day. **God's favor** can shield you from harm, limitations, and lack. It's a covering that allows you to walk confidently, no matter what the circumstances are, knowing that God is for you, not against you. It's available to all who believe and expect it.
- B. **Favor** is a divine advantage. It's the <u>supernatural grace</u> that enables you to accomplish things you could never achieve on your own. It's God working behind the scenes on your behalf, opening doors no one else can open and granting you opportunities that others might call impossible. Favor is what enables you to do with ease what you could never do on your own.
- **c.** For you, O lord, will bless the righteous; With **favor** You will surround him as with a shield. Psalms 5:12 NKJV
- D. To proclaim the accepted and acceptable year of the Lord (the day when salvation and the free **favor** of God profusely abound) Luke 4:19 AMP
