"Jesus Christ purchased the Believer's authority on the Cross & His Resurrection from the Grave"

"Stop" ask the Holy Spirit to help you understand God's Word, because He is the "Spirit of Truth"

"Please, do not speed read this supernatural teaching", read, study, meditate and DO His Word.

Key Scriptures:

Matthew 28:18 (NKJV)- And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to Me." This verse emphasizes the authority given to Jesus and extends to believers as His followers.

Romans 8:37 (NKJV) - "Yet, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us." This verse serves as a reminder of the <u>power</u> and <u>strength</u> <u>believers have in Christ</u>, enabling them to overcome challenges and live victoriously.

John 17:13 (NKJV) - "But now I come to You, and these things I speak in the world, that they may have My (Jesus) JOY fulfilled in themselves."

1. What is the "Power of Attorney" in the "Name of Jesus"?

John 16:23-24 (NKJV) - "And in that day you will ask Me nothing. Most assuredly, I say to you, whatever you ask the Father in My name He will give you. Until now you have asked nothing in My name. Ask, and you will receive, that your joy may be full." John 16:23-24 (AMP) - "And when that time comes, you will ask nothing of Me (you will need to ask Me no questions). I assure you, most solemnly I tell you, that My Father will grant you whatever you ask in My Name (as representing all that I AM). Up to this time you have not asked a (single) thing in My Name; (as representing all that I AM), but now ask and keep on asking and you will receive, so that your joy (gladness, delight) may be full and complete."

- Commentary

- Authority in the <u>Name of Jesus</u>: Jesus gave every Born-Again Believer on earth the authority to use that name. The transfer of this type of authority in our world today is what is recognized in legal terms as <u>"The Power of Attorney</u>." Jesus has given us the <u>power and authority</u> to do on earth what He did when He was here. For us, that will be what is called <u>"Power of Attorney</u>."
- John 16:12-15 (NKJV) "I still have many things to say to you, but you cannot bear them now. However, when He, the **Spirit of Truth**, has come, He will guide you into all truth, for He will not speak on His own authority, but whatever He hears (from the God head) He will speak, and He will tell you things to come. He will glorify Me, for He will take of what is Mine and declare it to you. All things that the Father has are Mine. Therefore, I said that He will take of Mine and declare it to you."

2. Jesus Christ, the Name above all Names

Philippians 2:9-11 (NKJV) - "Therefore God has highly exalted Him and given Him the name which is above every name, that at the "Name of Jesus" every knee should bow, of those in heaven, and those on earth, and those under the earth, and that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father."

- Matthew 28:18 (NKJV) "And <u>Jesus came and spoke</u> to them, saying, <u>"All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth.""</u>
- Hebrews 13:8 (NKJV) "Jesus Christ the same yesterday, today and forever."

 Acts 4:12 (NKJV) - "Nor is there salvation in any other, for there is no other name (Jesus) under heaven given among men by which we must be saved." (Born Again)

3. The Power of the Truth of God

John 8:31-32 (NKJV) - "Then Jesus said to those Jews who believed Him, "If you abide in My word, you are My disciple indeed. And you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.""

John 17:17 (NKJV) - "Sanctify them by Your Truth. Your Word is Truth."

John 14:16-17 (NKJV) - "And I will pray the Father, and He will give you another

Helper, that He may abide with you forever, the Spirit of Truth, whom the world
cannot receive, because it neither sees Him nor knows Him, but you know Him, for
He dwells with you and will be in you."

Commentary

In the early church during or after the main event, people would be saved, or healed, or baptized in the Holy Spirit or raised from the dead. In most of the organized churches today after the main event, they say it was a good message. God help us. The Holy Spirit and the Kingdom of God is 100 percent supernatural, so where there are miracles, that means the Holy Spirit was allowed to have His way and the Kingdom of God has shown up. Acts 4:30, Jn. 4:48, Matt. 17:20, Acts 3:16, Mk. 9:23, Rom. 15:18-19, Acts 19:11-12, Acts 4:29-31, Mk. 16:17-20

- Story by Benny Hinn – One service that Benny was leading the Holy Spirit spoke to him and told him to put an empty chair on the platform and then leave the platform, so He, the Holy Spirit, could have His way. When he did that, the Holy Spirit filled the place with His presence and people began to flood the altar and miracles began to happen all over with no man getting credit.

4. The Power of Binding & Loosing

Matthew 16:19 (NKJV) - "And I will give you the keys of the <u>kingdom of heaven</u>, and whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever, you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven."

Matthew 16:19 (AMP) - "I will give you the keys of the <u>kingdom of heaven</u>, and whatever you bind (declare to be improper and unlawful) on earth must be what is <u>already bound in heaven</u>, and whatever you loose (declare lawful) on earth must <u>be what is already loosed in heaven."</u>

5. Principalities & Powers

Ephesians 6:12 (NKJV) - "For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places (2nd heaven)."

I John 4:4 (NKJV) - "You are of God, little children, and have overcome them, because He (Holy Spirit) who is in you is greater than he who is in the world."

Luke 10:18-20 (NKJV) - "And He said to them, "I saw Satan fall like lightning from heaven. Behold, I give you the authority to trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

Nevertheless, do not rejoice in this, that the spirits are subject to you, but rather rejoice because your names are written in heaven." (when you are Born Again)"

Commentary

When we moved to SW Michigan in 1981 the Holy Spirit showed us that the main <u>Principality and Power</u> over this area (territory) was, the <u>"spirit of religion</u>". It is an evil spirit from the enemy that affects many things, including many churches.

Ephesians 6:12 (NJKJV) - "For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places."

Mark 7:13 (NKJV) - "Making the <u>Word of God</u> of <u>no effect</u> through your <u>tradition</u> (man's ways) which you have handed down. And many such things you do."

- Then some years later the Holy Spirit spoke to me (Bob) and said that the <u>spirit of slumber or stupor</u> was working in this SW Michigan territory <u>working with the spirit of religion.</u>
 - Romans 11:5-10, Matthew 25:5, Rev. 3:16 Also, David Wilkerson has a teaching on this subject on-line.
- In more recent years the Lord said that we should not compare one church to another, we should compare every church to the <u>Bible and the early church</u>. They regularly operated in the supernatural with salvations, divine healings, baptisms in the Holy Spirit and people raised from the dead. That is cooperating with the <u>Holy Spirit</u> and the <u>Kingdom of God</u>.

6. The Armor of God

Ephesians 6:10-18 (NKJV) "Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might. Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places. Therefore, take up the

whole armor of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand. Stand therefore, having girded your waist with truth, having put on the breastplate of righteousness, and having shod your feet with the preparation of the gospel of peace, above all, taking the shield of faith with which you will be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked one. And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God, praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit (tongues), being watchful to this end with all perseverance and supplication for all the saints."

Revelation 12:11 (NKJV) "And they overcame him (the enemy) by the blood of the Lamb (Jesus, Romans 10:9-10) and by the word of their testimony, and they did not love their lives to the death."

- Living Commentary by Andrew Wommack - Notice also that those who overcame the devil by the blood of the lamb and the word of their testimony also loved not their lives until the death. The Amplified Bible says, and they overcame and conquered him because of the <u>blood of the lamb</u> and because of the <u>word of their testimony</u>, for they did not love their lives and renounce their faith even when faced with death. The Message Bible says they defeated him through the blood of the lamb and the bold word of their witness (Acts 1:8). They weren't in love with themselves; they were willing to die for Christ.

7. Death and Life is in the power of your tongue

Proverbs 18:21 "**Death** and **Life** are in the power of the tongue, and those who love it will eat its fruit."

- A. James 3:2 (NKJV) "For we all stumble in many things. If anyone does not stumble in word, he is a perfect man, able to bridle the whole body."
- B. James 3:8-10 (NKJV) "But no man can tame the tongue. It is an unruly evil, full of deadly poison. With it we bless our God and Father, and with it we curse men, who have been made in the similitude (likeness) of God. Out of the same mouth proceed blessing and cursing. My brethren, these things ought not be so."
- C. Matthew 12:36-37 (NKJV) "But I say you that for every idle word men may speak, they will give account of it in the day of judgement. For by your words, you will be justified, and by your words you will be condemned.""
- D. Mark 11:22-24 (NKJV) "So Jesus answered and said to them, "Have faith in God. For assuredly, I <u>say</u> (speak) to you, whoever <u>says</u> (speaks) to this mountain, be removed and be cast into the sea, and does not doubt in his heart, but <u>believes</u> that those things he <u>says</u> (speaks) will be done, he will have whatever he <u>says</u> (speaks). Therefore, I <u>say</u> (speak) to you, whatever things you ask (speak) when you pray, <u>believe</u> that you receive them, and you will have them."

Commentary

Therefore, no man alone can tame the tongue, but the Holy Spirit and the Truth of the Word of God can do what man cannot.

8. The Believer's Authority

Luke 9:1-2 (NKJV) - "Then He called His twelve disciples together and gave them power and authority over all demons, and to <u>cure diseases</u>. He sent them to <u>preach the **kingdom of God**</u> and to <u>heal the sick</u>."

Luke 10:19-20 (NKJV) - "Behold, I give you **authority** to trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means hurt you. Nevertheless, do not rejoice in this, that the spirits are subject to you, but rather rejoice because your names are written in **heaven.**"

Understanding our Authority

We often ponder our place in God's Kingdom and how we, as believers, hold authority in His plans. The scriptures emphasizes that all authority has been given to Jesus, which extends to us as His followers. When we accept Christ, we became part of His family and receive the power to make a difference in our lives and the lives of others. This recognition of our authority helps us understand our role in combating sin and spreading the message of love, hope, and salvation.

We have the tools, through prayer and faith, to carry out God's will, and it encourages us to step boldly into unfamiliar situations, knowing we are backed by the Creator of the universe.

Caution – We don't want to confuse <u>Boldness</u> with <u>Pride</u>. Holy Spirit boldness comes when a Believer is anointed by the Spirit of God. Acts 10:38, I Jn. 2:20, Jn. 7:38-39. Pride usually comes from the flesh or the enemy. The Bible says that <u>Pride</u> comes before a fall. Proverbs 16:18, 11:2 And, Lucifer was kicked out of heaven due to <u>Pride</u>. Isaiah 14:12, Rev. 12:9

Living Commentary by Andrew Wommack

The statement that "nothing shall by any means hurt you" must be clarified. Paul was beaten many times with rods and whips, as well as stoned. (II Corinthians 11:23-25, Steven in Acts 7), and others were killed. So, this can't mean there will never be any physical harm. A similar passage in Luke 21:18 says, "...but there shall not any hair of your head perish." The context of that verse says some would be killed - Luke 21:16-17. Then it says that not a hair of your head shall perish. So, that

certainly isn't speaking about just the physical realm. Although these are examples of God's protection from harm by the physical creation (Genesis 9:2. Judges 14:5-6, and Acts 28 3-5), this scripture is speaking of mastery over the spiritual realm of the enemy (i.e., Satan). This scripture does not say that Satan cannot inflict any harm. The scriptures abound with examples and warnings of the enemy's danger to the godly and the ungodly alike; II Corinthians 2:11, II Timothy 2:26, and I Peter 5 8-9. However, he cannot harm us when we are walking in faith in Christ's redemptive work. Jesus was instructing His disciples not to rejoice in their accomplishments for God (the demons being subject unto them) but rather what God has done for them (their names being written in heaven). This discourages pride and it's the same message as in Jeremiah 9:23-24, I Corinthians 1:26-29, and II Corinthians 10:17.

Commentary

Jesus gives the disciples the authority to use the power He transferred to them. In other words, the <u>authority of the Believer is when Faith is being activated</u>. And **Faith is voice activated**. And so is doubt and unbelief. In other words, do not speak death to yourself or others - Proverbs 18:21, James chapter 3.

- John 14:12-13 (NKJV) "Most assuredly, I say to you, he who believes in Me (Jesus), the works that I do he will do also, and greater works than these he will do, **BECAUSE** I go to My Father. And whatever you ask (declare in faith) in My name, that I will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. If you ask (declare in faith) anything in My name, I will do it."
- Matthew 18:19 (NKJV) "Again I say to you, that if **two of you agree** on earth concerning anything that they ask, it will be done for them by My Father in heaven."
- Matthew 10:7-8 (NKJV) "And as you go preach, saying, The <u>Kingdom of heaven</u> is at hand. <u>Heal the sick</u>, <u>cleanse the lepers</u>, <u>raise the dead</u>, <u>cast out demons</u>. Freely you have received, **freely give.**"
- Mark 16:17-18 (NKJV) "And these signs will follow those who believe: In My name they will cast out demons; they will speak with new tongues; they will take up serpents; and if they drink anything deadly, it will by no means hurt them; they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover."
- Mark 11:23 (NKJV) "For assuredly, I say to you, whoever <u>says</u> (<u>speaks</u>) to this mountain, Be removed and be cast into the sea, and <u>does not doubt in his heart</u>, but <u>believes</u> that those things he <u>says</u> (<u>speaks</u>) will be done, he will have whatever he <u>says</u> (<u>speaks</u>)."
- I John 4:4-6 (NKJV) "You are of God, little children, and have overcome them, because He who is in you is greater than he who is in the world. They are of the

- world. Therefore, they speak as of the world, and the world hears them. We are of God. He who knows God hears us, he who is not of God does not hear us. By this we know the spirit of truth and the spirit of error. "
- I Peter 5:5-7 (NKJV) "Likewise you younger people, submit yourselves to your elders. Yes, all of you be submissive to one another, and be <u>clothed with</u>

 <u>humility</u>, for <u>God resists the proud</u>, but <u>gives grace to the humble</u>. Therefore,

 <u>humble yourselves under the mighty hand of God</u>, that <u>He (Jesus) may exalt you</u>
 in due time, casting all your care upon Him, for He cares for you."

9. A Spiritual Dream on Sunday 5-15-22

According to Acts 2:17 concerning dreams. I (Bob) had a spiritual dream again. The Lord (Jesus) was wanting to emphasize again the importance to Believers about who it is who calls people into one of the five-fold ministries. It is not man; it is Jesus Himself. Man can only recognize what Jesus has already done. According to Ephesians 4:11-13 "And He Himself (Jesus) gave some to be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, and some pastors and teachers. (For what reason?) For the equipping of the saints for the work of ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ. Till we all come to the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to a perfect man, to the measure of the stature of Christ." It is also appropriate and scriptural to call the fivefold ministry positions by their titles: Examples – Apostle Bernie, Prophet Ed, Evangelist Bruce, Pastor Will, Teacher Bob. This is not religious; this is the Kingdom of God. Believers should serve the Kingdom of God and help fulfill the Great Commission and become Ambassadors for Heaven/Christ. Acts 1:8, Matt. 28:18-20, Mark 16:14-18, Il Cor. 5:20, Eph 6:20

10. Living as Ambassadors

The authority we hold as believers extends beyond ourselves. We are **ambassadors of Christ**, called to represent Him in our actions, words, and relationship with others. Our authority allows us to bear witness to **God's love** and **grace** and to influence our communities positively. The way we live reflects the **Kingdom of God** and demonstrates how we are to act as representatives of Christ. We are tasked with the responsibility of <u>sharing the good news</u> and bringing hope to those around us. How we conduct ourselves can have a profound impact, and we should always strive to honor our calling as **ambassadors** in this world.

Romans 14:16-17 (NKJV) - "Therefore do not let your good be spoken of us as evil; for the **kingdom of God** is not eating and drinking but **righteousness and peace and joy** in the **Holy Spirit**."

11. The Ministry of the Month

Heidi Baker founded Iris Global in 1980 with her husband Rolland, and they began ministering together in Asia. In 1995 they were called to the poorest country in the world at the time, Mozambique, and faced an extreme test of the Gospel. They began by pouring out their lives among abandoned street children, and as the Holy Spirit moved miraculously in many ways, a revival movement spread to adults, pastors, churches and then throughout the bush all across Mozambique's ten provinces.
