“**Stop**” ask the Holy Spirit to help you understand God’s Word, because He is the “**Spirit of Truth**”.

Key Scriptures

John 8:31-32 (NKJV) Then Jesus said to those Jews who believed Him, “**If you abide in My word, you are my disciples indeed. And you shall know the **truth**, and the **truth** shall make you free**”.

Romans 12:1-2 (NKJV) I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a **Living Sacrifice**, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service. And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the **renewing of your mind**, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.

Hebrews 11:6 (NKJV) But **without faith it is impossible to please Him**, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.

Hosea 4:6a (NKJV) My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge.

1. The 7 Motivational Gifts, given by God the Father, at birth

Romans 12:6-8 (The Passion Translation (TPT)) - God's marvelous grace imparts to each one of us varying gifts. So, if God has given you the grace-gift of **prophecy**, activate your gift by using the proportion of faith you have to prophecy. If your grace-gift is **serving**, then thrive in serving others well. If you have the grace-gift of **teaching**, then be actively teaching and training others. If you have the grace-gift of **encouragement**, then use it often to encourage others. If you have the grace-gift of **giving** to meet the needs of others, then may you proposer in your generosity without any fanfare. If you have the gift of **leadership**, be passionate about your leadership. And if you have the gift of showing **compassion**, then flourish in your cheerful display of compassion.

- Introduction – these are gifts that characterize basic **“Motivations”** that are inherent tendencies that characterize each different person by reason of the Creator's unique workmanship in their initial gifting at birth. Here lies an individual's basic abilities, life giftings, motivation, and their different strengths. These grace gifts at birth, really come alive more once a person becomes a Born-Again Believer in Jesus Christ according to: John 3:3- and Romans 10:8-13.
- Romans 12:4 (NKJV) “For as we have many members in one body, but all the members do not have the same function.”
- Romans 12:6-8 speaks powerfully about the diversity of gifts within the body of Christ. As believers, we are all unique and are each given different gifts, at different strengths that serve various purposes. These scriptures emphasize that while our gifts may differ, they come from the same source – the grace of God. In essence, it invites us to recognize and accept that we have distinct roles to play within the Kingdom of God.
- **” Let's just go ahead and be what we were made to be, without enviously or pridefully comparing ourselves with each other, or trying to be something we aren't.”**
- **Also, remember, we are not talking about the 9 gifts of the Holy Spirit in this teaching, found in I Cor. 12:4-11.**

A. The grace gift of Prophecy

This gift involves declaring God's truth and bringing conviction. Those with the **gift of prophecy** are often able to discern motives and speak boldly about right and wrong.

Prophecy – has insight and boldness to speak.

B. The grace gift of Service

Individuals with this gift are driven to meet practical needs and demonstrate love through acts of **service**. They enjoy working behind the scenes to support others.

C. The grace gift of Teaching

This gift is characterized by the ability to explain and apply biblical truths clearly. **Teachers** help others understand the Word of God and grow in their faith.

D. The grace gift of Exhortation

Those with the **gift of exhortation** encourage and uplift others, often providing comfort and motivation to help them persevere in their faith.

E. The grace gift of Giving

This gift involves a generous spirit and a desire to share resources with others. Those who possess this **gift of giving** often give freely and joyfully to support the needs of the Body of Christ and others.

F. The grace gift of Leadership

Individuals with the **gift of leadership** are able to guide and direct others effectively. They take initiative and inspire others to work towards common goals.

G. The grace gift of Mercy/Compassion

This gift is characterized by a deep mercy/compassion for those who are suffering. Those with the **gift of mercy/compassion** are sensitive to the needs of others and provide comfort and support.

- **Significance of these Gifts**

These gifts are not just for personal benefit; they are meant to be used in service to others and to glorify God. Each believer is encouraged to identify and develop their **spiritual gifts**, using them to contribute to the health and growth of the Body of Christ, as well as to help themselves develop their own abilities to advance in their work career. Understanding these gifts can help believers appreciate their unique roles and the diverse ways God works through His people.

By recognizing and utilizing their gifts, Christians can fulfill their calling and make a meaningful impact in their communities and help themselves develop their personal abilities in their secular work and lives.

Examples of these gifts helping us in our secular & spiritual lives

- a. The **gift of leadership** can help a person find work in positions of business supervision & management and maybe own your own business.
In spiritual areas, this gift can help us in areas like: teaching in church, Bible studies at home, leadership positions in church like, elder, deacon, or one of the five-fold ministry gifts, when called to these areas.
- b. The **gift of teaching** can help a person find work in God's Kingdom, or in a secular job of helping train people and many other applications. The gift of teaching appears in two gift areas, here in Romans 12 and as one of the five-fold gifts in Eph. 4:11. The Motivational gift given at birth, and the gift in Eph. 4:11 given when a person is called into a five-fold office gift, by Jesus.
- c. The **gift of serving** can involve several areas of work like, home care, nursing, janitorial, service/help in local missions or church, plus many other areas of work in spiritual or secular work.
- **Knowing how you score/rate with the Motivational Gifts can be very important with married couples. When a married couple understands these gifts in their partner and their own lives, it can make a huge difference in how they work together in their marriage.**
- These are just some ideas of how these gifts can be applied/used to our daily lives.
- I Peter 4:10 (NKJV) As each one has received a gift, minister it to one another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God.
- Philippians 2:4 (NKJV) Let each of you look out not only for his own interests, but also for the interest of others.

2. **The Anointing by the Holy Spirit**

Acts 2:1-4 (NKJV) When the **Day of Pentecost** had fully come, they were all with **one accord** in one place. And **suddenly** there came a sound from heaven, as a rushing mighty wind, and it filled the whole house where they were sitting. Then there appeared to them **divided tongues**, as of fire, and one sat upon each of them. And

they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and **began to speak with other tongues**, as the **Spirit** gave them utterance.

- Remember, 120 were present on the Day of Pentecost, but there were 380 that missed this outpouring, from the original 500 people, according to the Bible.
- Acts 4:31 (NKJV) And when they had prayed, the place where they were assembled together was shaken, and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit, and they spoke the Word of God with boldness.
- Acts 10:44 (NKJV) While Peter was still speaking these words, the Holy Spirit fell upon all those who heard the word.
- **New Wine** – Joel 2:23-24 (NKJV) Be glad then you children of Zion, and rejoice in the Lord your God. For He has given you the former (outpouring of the Holy Spirit) faithfully, and He will cause the rain to come down for you, the **former rain**, and the **latter rain** (last days outpouring of the Holy Spirit) in the first month. (a double portion) The threshing floor shall be full of wheat, (harvest) and the vats shall overflow with new wine and oil (anointing of the Holy Spirit).
- Then in the fall of 2003, the Lord gave me (Bob) another **“Open Vision”** showing a **new wineskin**, that was very full of new wine; in fact, it was bulging almost ready to burst. Then I saw this man’s hand with a sword in it, and he thrust the sword into the new wineskin and the **wine** began to run down the sword and over the man’s hand. Then, the Lord again gave me the interpretation of this **vision**. The new wine represents the current and **coming outpouring of the Holy Spirit to the world**. The **New Wineskin** represents the Churches, Christian organizations and even House Group that are following and obedient to **Biblical Truth**, the commands of the Lord Jesus, and are part of the **Kingdom of God**. The **Sword** represents the **Word of God** going forth out of Believer’s mouths and helping to bring forth this new wine (Holy Spirit anointing), keeping its purpose pure, correct, and scriptural, so this **last day’s harvest of souls** will come forth with great power, majesty, and glory, with **signs and wonders**.
- Matthew 24:14 (NKJV) **“And this gospel of the Kingdom will be preached in all the world as a witness to all nations, and then the end will come.”**
- I John 2:27 (NKJV) But the **anointing** which you have received from Him (Jesus) abides in you, and you do not need that anyone teach you; but as the same **anointing** teaches you concerning all things, and is true, and is not a lie, and just as it has taught you, you will abide in Him.

3. **Prophetic Words for the Last Days**

- On a Saturday night in January 2021 the Lord woke me (Jean) up and said, my people are “**Asleep**”, “**Wake Up**”, “**Sound the Alarm**”, “**Blow the Shofar**”, “**Wake them Up**”. (Joel 2:1)
- **Spirit of Slumber** – One morning when I (Bob) was brushing my teeth in 2006 God spoke to me and said: “The spirit of slumber was a problem that was working with the spirit of religion in southwest Michigan. Then in researching this we found a message by David Wilkerson on this subject and he said that when a Christian has this problem with the spirit of slumber in their life, that their human spirit is asleep (message on June 5th, 1985). Then the Sanford’s from Elijah House counseling ministry says: they found after many years of research and experience that some Christian human spirit is in a “coma.”

4. Three ways that even a Christian could miss heaven

a. **Unforgiveness and Offenses**

Mark 11:25-26 (NKJV) *And whenever you stand praying, if you have anything against anyone, forgive him, that your Father in heaven may also forgive you your trespasses. But if you do not forgive, neither will your Father in heaven forgive your trespasses.*

Forgiveness as a Response – Forgiveness is a powerful remedy against **offenses**. When we are hurt, we naturally feel the weight of anger and resentment. Yet, we are called to **extend forgiveness**, just as Christ has forgiven us. Let’s remember that holding onto offenses damage our hearts. Instead of nursing our grievances, we can look at forgiveness as a gift we give ourselves and others. True healing begins when we **choose compassion** over frustration. Embracing forgiveness breaks the chains of bitterness and replaces them with **love** and **understanding**.

b. **Pride**

James 4:6-7 (NKJV) But He gives more grace. Therefore, He says: “**God resist the proud**, but gives grace to the **humble**.” Therefore, submit to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you.

Also, God kicked Lucifer out of heaven because of **Pride**, found in Isaiah 14:12 and Ezekiel 28:12-17.

c. **Lukewarmness and falling asleep spiritually**

- Revelation 3:16 (NKJV) *So then, because you are **lukewarm**, and neither cold nor hot, I (Jesus) will vomit you out of My mouth.*
- Matthew 25:1-13 (NKJV) “*Then the **kingdom of heaven** shall be likened to ten virgins who took their lamps and went out to meet the bridegroom (Jesus). Now*

five of them were wise, and five were foolish. Those who were foolish took their lamps and took no oil with them, but the wise took oil in their vessels with their lamps. But while the bridegroom was delayed, they all slumbered and slept. And at midnight a cry was heard: 'Behold, the bridegroom is coming; go out to meet him! Then all those virgins arose and trimmed their lamps. And the foolish said to the wise, 'Give us some of your oil, for our lamps are going out.' But the wise answered, saying, 'No, lest there should not be enough for us and you; but go rather to those who sell, and buy for yourselves. And while they went to buy, the bridegroom came, and those who were ready went in with him to the wedding; and the door was shut. (like God shut the door on the Ark)

5. Salvation in no other, except by Jesus Christ

Acts 4:12 (TPT) There is no one else who has the power to save us, for there is only one name to whom God has given authority by which we must experience salvation: the name of Jesus."
