This month of January 2026 we are Teaching on “**Truth & Wisdom**” and “**Self-Deliverance**”.

” **Stop**”, pray and ask the Holy Spirit to help you understand this teaching. And, also apply the scriptures to your life and continue to grow spiritually.

**Note: All scriptural references are NKJV unless otherwise noted.**

### **Foundational Scriptures**

John 8:31-32 - Then Jesus said to those Jews who believed Him. “If you abide in My word, you are My disciple indeed. And you shall know the **truth**, and the **truth** shall make you free”.

Colossians 4:5-6 - Walk in **wisdom** toward those who are outside, redeeming the time. Let your speech always be with **grace**, seasoned with **salt**, that you may know how you ought to answer each one.

Hebrews 11:6 - But without **Faith** it is impossible to please Him (God), for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder to those who diligently seek Him.

John 10:10 - **“The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly”.**

Galatians 5:15-16 - But if you bite and **devour one another**, beware lest you be consumed by one another! I say then: Walk in the Spirit and you shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh. For the flesh lusts against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh; and these are contrary to one another, so that you do not do the things that you wish.

Philippians 4:8-9 - Finally, brethren, whatever things are **true**, whatever things are **noble**, whatever things are **just**, whatever things are **pure**, whatever things are **lovely**, whatever things are of **good report**, if there is any **virtue** and if there is anything **praiseworthy** – meditate on these things. The things which you **learned** and **received** and heard and saw in me, these do, and the God of peace will be with you.

Romans 12:1-2 - I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a “LIVING SACRIFICE”, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service. And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.

### **1. Walking in “Truth & Wisdom”**

II Timothy 3:16 - All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness, that the man of God may be complete, thoroughly equipped for every good work.

Hebrews 4:12 - For the word of God is living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of **soul** and **spirit**, and of joints and marrow, and is a discernor of the thoughts and intents of the heart.

III John 1:3-4 - For I rejoiced greatly when brethren came and testified of the **truth** that is in you, just as you **walk in the truth**. I have no greater **joy** than to hear that my children **walk in truth**.

### **Commentary on Truth**

John 8:31-32 - Then Jesus said to those Jews who believed Him. **“If you abide in My word, you are My disciple indeed. And you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free”.**

John 17:17 - Sanctify them by Your **truth**. Your word is **truth**.

II Timothy 2:15 - Be diligent to present yourself approved to God, a worker who does not need to be ashamed, rightly dividing the **word of truth**.

The **truth** found in the Bible does not only impact our immediate circumstances but the entire journey of our lives. We can rely on God's word to guide us through every phase of life. As believers, we often turn to the Bible as our source of **truth** and **guidance**. The authority of Scripture reminds us that it is not just a collection of ancient writings but the inspired word of God. Through the Holy Spirit, we find that the words of the Bible hold authority over our lives and decisions. The scriptures help us **discern the truth** from **lies** in a confusing world.

### **Commentary on Wisdom**

Understanding where **wisdom** comes from is critical for our journey of **faith**. The Bible makes it clear that true **wisdom is a gift from God**. When we acknowledge that the Lord is the source, we empower ourselves to seek Him diligently. As we pursue **wisdom**, we are called to actively seek it in our day to day lives. This quest for **wisdom** is not a passive endeavor; it requires intention and effort. **Wisdom** is immensely valuable, surpassing material wealth and superficial gains. In a world often consumed by materialism, the Bible reminds us that valuing **wisdom** can lead to deeper satisfaction and fulfillment in life. It brings **peace, clarity, and purpose**, allowing us to navigate life with **grace and discernment**.

James 1:5 - If any of you **lack wisdom**, let him ask of God, who gives to all liberally and without reproach, and it will be given to him.

Proverbs 1:5 - A **wise** man will hear and increase learning, And the man who gains understanding will attain **wise** counsel.

Proverbs 3:13-18 - Happy is the man who finds **wisdom**, and the man who gains understanding; for her proceeds are better than the profits of silver, and her gain then fine gold. She is more precious than rubies, and all the things you may desire cannot compare with her. Length of days is in her right hand, in all her paths are peace. She is a tree of life to those who take hold of her, and happy are all who retain her (wisdom).

### **Believers' authority over demonic spirits (speak out-loud)**

Luke 9:1- Then He called His twelve disciples and **gave them power and authority over all demons, and to cure diseases**.

James 4:7-8a - Therefore submit to God. **Resist the devil** and he will flee from you. Draw near to God and He will draw near to you.

Ephesians 6:16 - Above all, taking the **shield of faith** with which you will be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked one.

Luke 10:18-19 And He said to them, “I saw satan fall like lightning from heaven. Behold, I give you the authority to trample on serpents and scorpions, and **over all the power of the enemy**, and nothing shall by any means hurt you.”

## **2. The devil and demons**

Demons are the demonic army of the devil/satan on earth.

Lucifer was one of three archangels who were in heaven in the beginning, and he became **prideful** and rebelled against God. God kicked him out of heaven to the earth and he has been known as the devil or satan (meaning “adversary”) from that point on.

### **Commentary on demonic influence**

- Any person can be affected/troubled in the flesh/body when they open themselves up to evil forces by their **behavior and actions** (open the door).
- But they can also be **set-free** by exercising their will and by **binding & casting** out these **demonic forces**.
- Also, the person can **stay free** if they stay **filled with God’s Word** and the **Holy Spirit**.

It basically says in Matthew 12:43 **serve Jesus** and the **Kingdom of God** and **do not open the doors of evil forces** again by your **behavior and actions**.

## **3. “Self-Deliverance”**

**Pride** – James 4:6 But He gives more grace. Therefore, He says: **“God resists the proud, “But gives grace to the humble”**. **Humble yourself** (I Peter 5:6)

- **Repentance** – (speak out-loud)

**Acts 3:19** - **Repent** therefore and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, so that times of refreshing may come from the presence of the Lord...

**I John 1:9** - If we **confess our sins**, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

**Matthew 4:17 - From that time Jesus began to preach and say, “Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand”.**

**Look over the list below of evil spirits or behaviors and, bind & cast-out those that you relate to:**

**SAY, out-loud “I bind & command to go from me, every one of these works of the flesh (evil spirits), that pertain to me, in Jesus Name”. Name the ones that pertain to you, and cast them out with boldness, In Jesus Name.**

**Bitterness-anger-slander (Eph. 4:30) lying spirit (Pro. 12:22, Matt. 7:15)), spirit of deception (Gal. 6:7-8), lust & pornography (I John 2:16), fear (II Timothy 1:7), worry (Phil. 4:6-7), arrogance (Pro. 8:13), laziness (I Tim. 5:8), spirit of witchcraft/divination (Rev. 21:8, Gal. 5:20, Rev. 9:21), conceit and envy (Gal. 5:25-26), controlling spirit (James 3:16), criticism (James 4:11-12), spirit of greed & lover of self (II Tim. 3:1-5), depression (Rom. 15:13, Phi. 4:4), legalism (Lk. 11:37-54), stealing (Eph. 4:28), unbelief (Heb. 3:19), spirit of infirmity (Luke 13:10-11), generational curse (Deut. 28:45-49), spirit of heaviness/suicide (Pro. 15:13, Luke 4:18), false doctrine (Eph. 4:14, II Peter 3:16-17), spirit of manipulation (I Tim. 4:1), spirit of nicotine/bondage (Eph. 6:12, Rom. 6:16, Luke 8:23)), alcoholism (Pro. 23-35, Lk. 1:15, Rom. 14-27), the spirit of betrayal & hate (Matt. 24:10), **Seducing spirits** (I Tim. 4:1, Mark 13:22) **Familiar spirit/false prophecy** (Gal. 5:20, Rev. 18:23), Works of the flesh are evident, which are: **adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lewdness, idolatry, sorcery, hatred, contentions, jealousies, outbursts, of wrath, selfish ambitions, dissensions, heresies, envy, murders, drunkenness, revelries, and the like; of which I tell you beforehand, just as I also told you in times past: that those who practice such things will not inherit the kingdom of God. (Gal. 5:19-21) But know this, in the last days** perilous times will come: For man will be **lovers of themselves, lovers of money, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy, unloving, unforgiving, slanders, without self-control, brutal, despisers of good, traitors, headstrong, haughty, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God, having a form of godliness but denying its power.****

II Timothy 3:1-5 - But know this, that in the last days perilous times will come: For men will be lovers of themselves, lovers of money, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy, unlovely, unforgiving, slanderers, without self-control, brutal, despisers of good, traitor, headstrong, haughty, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God, having a form of godliness but denying its power. And from such people turn away!

**Read & Confess the Statements Below (out-loud)**

- A. Father, I thank you for the Holy Spirit's Power, in the name of Jesus Christ.
- B. I enter boldly into your throne of grace and I receive mercy for all my short comings and grace to overcome them, in Jesus' name.
- C. I reject every activity of evil spirits in my life, in Jesus' name.
- D. I silence forever, every mouth of the wicked speaking against me, in Jesus' name.
- E. Every arrow of evil spirits sent to destroy me, be destroyed now, in the name of Jesus.
- F. No matter the forces of darkness working against me, I will arise and shine, in the name of Jesus.
- G. I release warring Angels to strike down all my oppressors, in the name of Jesus.
- H. I bind every stronghold, and cast them out, in my life, in Jesus' name.

1 Corinthians 3:16 - Do you not know that you are the temple of God and that the Spirit of God dwells in you?

Matthew 10:7-8 - "And as you go, preach, saying, The Kingdom of heaven is at hand.' Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, **cast out demons**. Freely you have received, freely give".

Romans 14:16-17 - Therefore do not let your good be spoken of as evil; **for the kingdom of God is not eating and drinking, but righteousness and peace and joy in the Holy Spirit.**

Ephesians 6:12 - For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places.

James 4:7-8a - Therefore submit to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you. Draw near to God and He will draw near to you.

### **Helping others guideline**

- A. Make sure the person has accepted Jesus as their personal Savior. Romans 3:23, Romans 6:23, Acts 3:19, John 3:5-7, Romans 10:9-13. If the person does not and will not receive Christ as Savior, stop here. Share more with the person about Jesus and leave a door of contact open with them.
- B. Ask the person what they would like to receive freedom from.
- C. Also, use the list of evil forces from the "Self-Deliverance" part of this teaching.

- D. Interview the person to discover the events or relationships that have led to bondage.
- E. And, attempt to identify the spirits involved in their problems.
- F. Lead the person to closing the doors through which the spirit has entered.
- G. If a spirit manifests, tell it to be quiet.
- H. When you are ready to cast out evil spirits, you name the spirit, and then **you bind them first**, then **cast them out**, in Jesus Name.
- Matthew 18:18 (AMP) “I assure you and most solemnly say to you, whatever you bind [forbid, declare to be improper and unlawful] on earth shall have [already] been bound in heaven, and whatever you loose [permit, declare lawful] on earth shall have [already] been loosed in heaven”.
  - Matthew 12:43-45 - “When an unclean spirit goes out of a man, he goes through dry places, seeking rest, and finds none. Then he says, ‘I will return to my house from which I came.’ And when he comes, he finds it empty, swept, and put in order. Then he goes and takes with him seven other spirits more wicked than himself, and they enter and dwell there; and the last state of that man is worse than the first. So shall it also be with this wicked generation.”
  - **A personal secret to stay free** – I (Bob) have for many years treated my **MIND** as a **FILTER**, not a **FUNNEL**. In other words, I try hard not to let any negative (unbiblical) information enter and stay in my mind, which then can enter my spirit, and potential become a stronghold in my life. Romans 12:1-2 I also depend on the Holy Spirit (Spirit of Truth) to help me sort out good & evil information. Heb. 5:14, I Thes. 5:21, Phil. 1:9-10. I also depend on the Gift of Discernment to help me discern Right & Wrong. I Cor. 1c Lastly, because Jesus has called me as a Bible Teacher in His Kingdom, I am responsible to Teach & Preach only the TRUTH. James 3:1, Eph. 4:11

#### **4. Scriptural Prayers for Deliverance (speak out-loud)**

- Psalm 32:7 You are my hiding place; You shall preserve me from trouble; You shall surround me with songs of deliverance.
- Galatians 5:1 Stand fast therefore in the liberty by which Christ has made us free, and do not be entangled again with a yoke of bondage.
- II Samuel 22:2-4 And he said: “The Lord is my rock and my fortress and my deliverer; The God of my strength, in whom I will trust; My shield and the horn of my salvation,

My stronghold and my refuge; My Savior, you save me from violence. I will call upon the Lord, who is worthy to be praised; So shall I be saved from my enemies.”

5. Jesus is looking for a **glorious church** (Born Again Believers) without spot or wrinkle or any such thing, but that she should be holy and without blemish. Ephesians 5:27
6. That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of those in heaven, and those on earth, and of those under the earth, and that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father. Philippians 2:10-11
7. Galatians 5:22-26 But the fruit of the Spirit is **love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control**. Against such there is not law. And those who are Christ's have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires. If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit. Let us not become conceited, provoking one another, envying one another. (A MUST to stay free)

**A Commentary to America – “Last Days Final Awakening”**



The American Dream as a Spiritual Vision – Charlie Kirk saw the American Dream through a biblical lens. To him, it was never merely about prosperity or property – it was about purpose. He believed America was founded on the idea that men and women are made in the image of God, endowed with dignity, freedom, and responsivity. He often quoted John Adams: “Our Constitution was made only for a moral and religious people. It is wholly inadequate to the government of any other.” Charlie loved that line because it said what he spent his life teaching – that liberty without virtue is unsustainable. He taught that the American Dream depends on moral renewal. He saw every cultural collapse as an invitation for revival. Yes, he loved and engaged heavily in politics, but he believed politics could never save a nation that had lost its soul. “We need a better people”. That conviction makes him dangerous to the leftist elites – and beloved by millions of ordinary Americans who still believe that **faith** and **freedom** rise or fall together.
